**Rights to inspect the Statement of Accounts and accounting records**

**Notice** is given that the unaudited statement of accounts of Northumberland County Council for the year ended 31 March 2022 will be available for inspection as determined below. The statement of accounts is unaudited and may be subject to change.

**Notice** is given that, during the periods and times specified below:

Monday 25 July 2022 to Friday 2 September 2022 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday

Any person interested or any journalist may inspect and make copies of the unaudited accounts of Northumberland County Council for the year ended 31 March 2022 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to them. The unaudited accounts will be available for inspection on the Council's website at [www.northumberland.gov.uk](http://www.northumberland.gov.uk) and all other documents will be made available upon request to Jan Willis, Interim Executive Director of Finance and Section 151 Officer, County Hall Morpeth, Northumberland, NE61 2EF or via email to [jan.willis@northumberland.gov.uk](mailto:jan.willis@northumberland.gov.uk).

**Rights to question the auditor and to make objections at audit**

**Notice** is also given that, under section 26 of the Local Accountability and Audit Act 2014, a local government elector may question the auditor about the accounting records for the financial year ended 31 March 2022 and, under section 27 of the Act, a local government elector may make an objection to the auditor which:

- concerns a matter in respect of which the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of the Act; or
- concerns an item of account in respect of which the auditor could apply for a declaration that the item is unlawful under section 28 of the Act.

These rights may be exercised between Monday 25 July 2022 and Friday 2 September 2022, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday.
