

Public Path Diversion Order

Highways Act 1980

Northumberland County Council

Parish of Craster (Public Footpath No 5) Diversion Order 2023

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council ("The Authority"), under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act"), because it appears to the Authority that, in the interests of the landowner, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Craster Parish Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

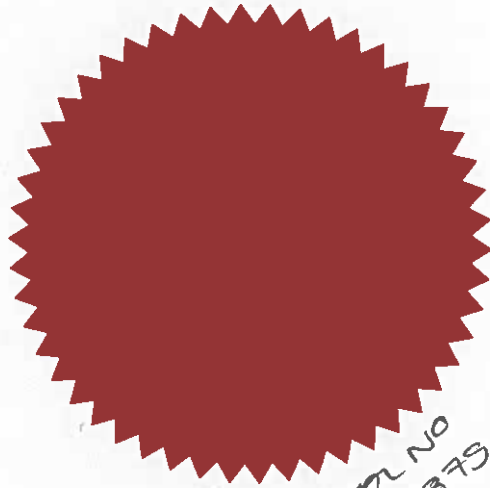
By this Order:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Dunstan Hill Farm and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 63 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 63 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Dunstan Hill and described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold dotted and dashed line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

Part 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Public Footpath No 5 (Parish of Craster)

From a point marked A, 195 metres north of Dunstan Hill farmhouse, in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres, then in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 90 metres to a point marked B, on Byway Open to All Traffic No 26, 155 metres north-west of Dunstan Hill farmhouse.

Part 2

Description of site of new path or way

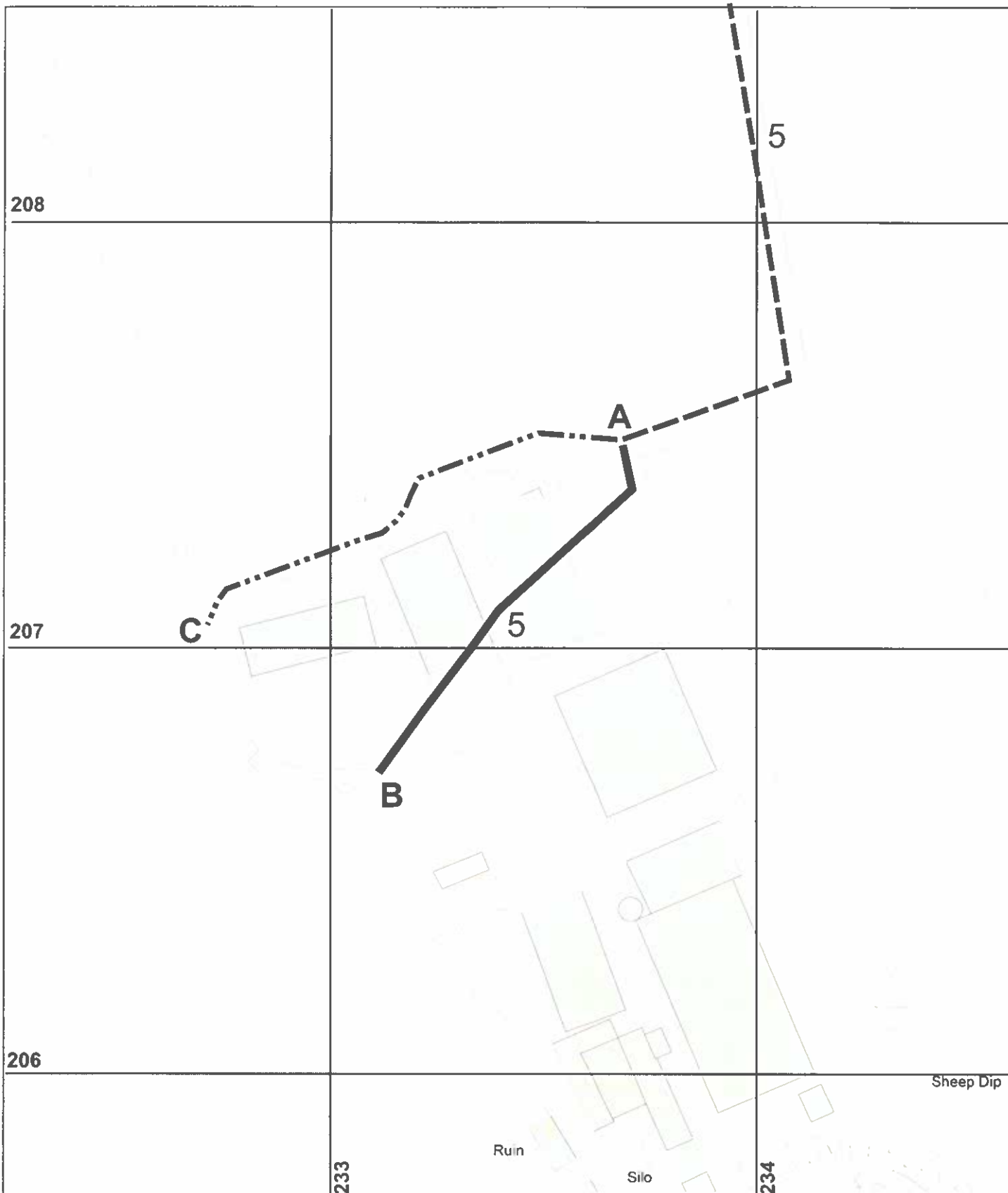
Public Footpath No 5 (Parish of Craster)

A 1.5 metre wide footpath, from a point marked A, 195 metres north of Dunstan Hill farmhouse, in a general westerly direction for a distance of 115 metres to a point marked C, on Byway Open to All Traffic No 26, 205 metres north-west of Dunstan Hill farmhouse.
