

Public Path Diversion Order

Highways Act 1980

Northumberland County Council

Parish of Hexhamshire Low Quarter (Public Footpath No 6) Diversion Order 2024

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council ("The Authority"), under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act"), because it appears to the Authority that, in the interests of the landowner, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Hexhamshire & District Parish Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

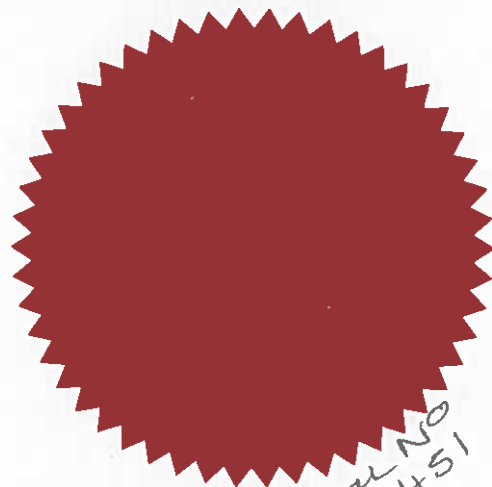
By this Order:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Tenter House, Low Juniper and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 63 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 63 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Tenter House, Low Juniper and described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold dotted and dashed line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

Part 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Public Footpath No 6 (Parish of Hexhamshire Low Quarter)

From a point marked A, 50 metres north-east of Tenter House, in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 220 metres to a point marked D, 120 metres south-west of Tenter House.

Part 2

Description of site of new path or way

Public Footpath No 6 (Parish of Hexhamshire Low Quarter)

A 2 metre wide footpath, from a point marked A, 50 metres north-east of Tenter House in a north-westerly direction for 25 metres to a point marked B and then proceeding in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 95 metres to a point marked C. The path then continues in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 115 metres to a point marked D, 120 metres south-west of Tenter House.

Part 3

Limitations and Conditions

1 pedestrian gate to comply with British Standard 5709 (2018) situated at Grid Reference NY 9368 5886.
