From the entrance to the school grounds, 15 metres north of number 18 Ripley Drive (OS grid ref: NZ 2604 7551), in a general northerly direction for a distance of 520 metres through the school site, to the school entrance adjacent to the cycle track, 15 metres south-west of number 38 Highburn (NZ 2609 7598).

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
