Definitive Map Modification Order (No 5) 2023

The above Order, made on 18th August 2023, was confirmed on 12th April 2024 and will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Former Tynedale District

Footpath No 48 (Parish of Chollerton)

Adding thereto a public footpath, from the U8156 road, 50 metres north of Stables Cottage, Gunnerton (O.S. Grid Ref NY 9052 7510), in an easterly direction for a distance of 95 metres, to the entrance to the Recreation Ground, 25 metres east of number 4 Bracken Hill (NY 9061 7510).

These details are shown on the Order map. The Order became operative 12th April 2024 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any regulation has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, within six weeks from 25th April 2024 make an application to the High Court for that purpose.
