# Highways Act 1980 Northumberland County Council

# Parish of Hexhamshire Low Quarter (Public Footpath No 6) Diversion Order 2024

The above Order was made on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2024 under section 119 of the Highways Act, 1980. The effect of the Order will be as follows:-

#### **Public Footpath No 6 (Parish of Hexhamshire Low Quarter)**

To extinguish the footpath, from a point 50 metres north-east of Tenter House (Grid Reference NY 9379 5887), in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 220 metres to a point 120 metres south-west of Tenter House (GR. NY 9362 5876).

To create a 2 metre wide footpath, from a point 50 metres north-east of Tenter House (GR. NY 9379 5887) in a north-westerly direction for 25 metres, then proceeding in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 95 metres. The path then continues in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 115 metres to a 120 metres south-west of Tenter House (GR. NY 9362 5876).

These details are shown on the Order map.
