

Adoption Example Profile: *This is a portrayal of children for whom we are seeking families*

Oliver is warm, friendly and affectionate boy who presents as quiet, passive and laid back. He wants to be liked and to 'fit in' and will show gratitude for everything that he receives.

Oliver can present as reserved and is often hesitant and nervous about doing anything new. He relies on his younger sister Eve to test new things and situations.



Oliver's school reports that he works well in class, he is keen to learn and is achieving at expected levels. His gross motor skills such as running, jumping, skipping, kicking a ball etc are under developed and he needs encouragement to engage in physical activity.

Eve is very confident, outgoing and talkative. She is very athletic and prefers physical games and activities.

Eve mixes easily although she can be 'bossy' and she needs help understanding that others have needs as well.

The children's birth parents have a history of drug and alcohol abuse and the full extent of mother's use of these during pregnancy is not known.

Contact: Indirect contact is envisaged with Oliver & Eve's birth parents and grandparents. Direct contact (twice yearly) is envisaged with older siblings
