

Adoption Example Profile: *This is a portrayal of children for whom we are seeking families*

Rosie is a young toddler who is always smiling and can be quite animated in her expressions.



Rosie has resided the majority of her young years in foster care having been removed from her parents care due to issues of neglect. She settled well into her placement and has developed well established routines.

Rosie is not of school age. She does occasionally attend a playgroup with her carer and mixes well with her peers during these sessions.

Rosie is described as a delightful little girl by her carers and social worker. She is meeting within the range of her expected milestones and has good mobility and coordination.

Rosie is a relatively easy child to care for and enjoys good health. She absorbs information and responds well to her carers nurturing approach. Rosie can understand much more than she can verbalize at present and sometimes gets frustrated when she does not have the words to communicate what she wants.

Rosie is very easily distracted if she becomes upset and can be quite easily soothed. She will readily give and receive cuddles and is described as a very pleasant little girl.

Contact: Future contact would be indirect once per year with birth parents.

Family Required: Rosie will need time and commitment from an adoptive family to develop her sense of attachment to them. Rosie requires a family who will not place great expectations on her, but will help her in reaching her true potential. It is felt Rosie's needs could be met in a one or two parent family. Rosie would benefit from being the youngest by at least 3 years.
