

Adoption Example Profile: This is a portrayal of children for whom we are seeking families

Sid and Al are brothers aged 4 and 5 who are looking to join a new family together.

Sid is an affectionate child who thrives on activity and one to one attention. He loves playing outdoors and has a keen interest in animals and nature. He has a good imagination which enables him to play happily on his own for periods of time. Sid likes playing with a wide range of toys but his favourites are his animal figures.

Al enjoys riding his bike and going for walks. He enjoys new experienced and loves visiting new places, especially if it involves a bus journey. He prefers games and activities which can include other adults or children. He is less able to play on his own as he quickly becomes bored.



Sid was born with a turned in left foot and had corrective surgery and currently receives orthopaedic support. He is physically energetic and his condition does not inhibit or impede him. Sid is socially behind that of his peers although he is beginning to 'catch up'. He has developed some friendships in school and is learning how to play co-operatively.
