## School Balances as at 31 March 2016

### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

To inform Schools Forum of the position regarding School Balances as at 31 March 2016.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Schools Forum members are recommended to note the contents of the report and the attached Appendices.

#### **BACKGROUND**

A total of 149 out of 157 maintained schools submitted their return regarding the use of School Balances as at 31 March 2016. Of the 8 schools who had not submitted a return by 1 September 2016, 7 were under the 5% / 8% limit. Only one school, who was also under the limit, still had to submit relevant documentation.

No maintained school still open at 1 September 2016 was in breach of the limits, set out in the Scheme for Financing Schools, after commitments.

Overall School Balances have increased by 5.6%. But there are differences within the different phases:

•	First/Primary Schools	Balances have increased by £502k (11.6%)
•	Middle Schools	Balances have increased by £241k (24.7%)
•	High/Secondary Schools	Balances have decreased by £209k (18.2%)
•	Special Schools	Balances have decreased by £105k (8.6%)

The number of schools with a deficit closing balance has increased from 25 to 28 and the size of the overall deficits has increased by 59% from £737k to £1.172m. Again there are differences within the phases:

First/Primary Schools
Middle Schools
High/Secondary Schools
Special Schools
Deficit balances decreased by £58k
Deficit balances increased by £336k
Deficit balances increased by £22k

The number of schools with a surplus closing balance has decreased from 132 to 129 and size of the overall surpluses has increased by 10% from £8.409m to £9.274m. The difference in the phases is below:

•	First/Primary Schools	Surplus balances increased by £444k
•	Middle Schools	Surplus balances increased by £376k
•	High/Secondary Schools	Surplus balances increased by £127k
•	Special Schools	Surplus balances decreased by £83k
