BACKGROUND

Northumberland County Council identified a need to establish new baselines for vitality and performance of centres in each of the main towns. A large amount of data had been collated and analysed against a range of indicators to create a picture of the relative health of the towns and this has exposed a gap in upto-date footfall information. The most recent County-wide study was carried out in 2013 and footfall analysis required updating.

During the Winter of 2019/2020 People and Places Insight Limited began a contract collecting footfall data, but due to the Covid-19 crisis this project had to be postponed. The schedule of towns where footfall was conducted is listed below.

METHODOLOGY

The arrival and movement of people, whether as residents, workers, visitors or shoppers are vital to the success of locations. Measuring passing people in a consistent manner in the same place, at the same time builds up a picture of the town, its traders and their relative success over the weeks and months. Footfall is a Key Performance Indicator in the People and Places Insight Limited Town Benchmarking System. Since 2004 over 350 towns and localities from across England, Wales, Republic of Ireland and Scotland have been collecting their footfall figures using the methodology.

Benchmarking footfall is conducted on weekdays in specific locations for a set period, between 10.00am to 1.00pm, counting the people passing in both directions through a fixed point (e.g. an imaginary line across the road) for a precise ten minutes in every hour (e.g. 10.00–10.10am, 11.20am-11.30am, 12.40pm-12.50pm). Aside from the above basic rules are applied to the process:

- An accurate stopwatch and a hand operated mechanical counter are used
- If a person walks passed more than once they are included in the count each time they pass through the 'line'
- Children under 12 are not included in the count
- Footfall counts are not conducted in weather conditions which will limit the number of town centre users i.e. heavy rain, snow

The Benchmarking system is divided into two sections:

- National Large Towns; consisting of those localities with more than 250 units
- National Small Towns; consisting of those localities with less than 250 units

Thus, in the key findings section of the report Towns depending on their size are compared to the National Large or Small Towns footfall averages.

In 2013, Northumberland County Council commissioned the Research team to conduct full Benchmarking in 12 locations and in late 2019 and early 2020 footfall was conducted in locations as identified in Page 3 before the Covid-19 lockdown, thus longitudinal data is available.

When offering longitudinal comparisons, footfall in Alnwick on the Market Day increased in the Winter of 2020 from the Autumn 2020 by 25%, however there is a marked drop of 37% from the Spring 2020 data.

Compared to the National figures the Winter Market Day count in Alnwick, 115 persons per ten minutes is slightly higher than the National Small Towns average of 110.

When offering longitudinal comparisons, footfall in Ashington on the Market Day decreased in the Winter of 2020 from the Autumn 2020 by 28%. Footfall in the town centre is markedly reduced from the 2013 average of 299 persons per ten minutes.

On a National level, both the Autumn (170) and Winter (123) averages are higher than the National Small Towns figures.

In both September and December, the Marygate Street count point provided the heaviest footfall, averaging 99 persons per ten minutes in the former and 110 persons per ten minutes in the latter. On both days in Marygate Street footfall increased as the morning progressed.

When offering longitudinal comparisons, footfall in Berwick on the Market Day increased in the Winter of 2020 from the Spring 2020 by 11%, however there is a drop of 38% from the 2013 data. Non-Market Day footfall counts were conducted in March 2020 and the figure of 129 persons per ten minutes is a 11% increase on the 2013 figure and higher than the Market Day figures recorded in Autumn and Winter 2020. Despite qualifying as a Large Town, Berwick's footfall figures are more aligned to the Small Towns averages.

When offering longitudinal comparisons, footfall in Blyth on the Market Day remained consistent across the Autumn (101) and Winter (105) counts. The 2020 averages were significantly lower than the 2019 averages, decreasing from 216 persons per ten minutes. Interestingly, Outside Iceland, Waterloo Road recorded the heaviest footfall figures in 2019.

In terms of National comparisons, Blyth's footfall figures in Winter and Autumn 2020 are close to the National Small Towns averages.
