Northumberland has a higher proportion of residents aged 65 and over (23.1%) than the North East and England, and this figure is projected to rise to 33.6% by 2039. The percentage figure for those aged 0–15 is projected to fall to 14.8% over the same period.


Resident's Perception

Crime and Justice

In the year ending March 2016, the crime rate in Northumberland was 46.3 per 1,000 residents, lower than the rate for the Northumbria Force area (65.5). The number of key notifiable offences of police recorded crime for 2015/16 was 14,646, which was 34% higher than the previous year (10,896 offences). Violent crime increased by 72% within this period *Source: Police UK*

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Economy and the Labour Market

- The total GVA for Northumberland in 2015 was £5,029, which represents 10.1% of the total GVA for the North East region.
- Between 1997 and 2015 the total GVA for the county increased by an average of 3% per year.
- GVA is much lower in Northumberland GVA per head was £14,979 compared to £18,216 across the North East and £24,958 in England.
- Unemployment in Northumberland (6.3%) is higher than the national level (5.2%) but lower than the regional level (7.7%).
- 2.3% of Northumberland residents of working age claimed Job Seekers Allowance in September 2016, compared to the England figure of 1.7%.
- Average weekly full time wage for residents in Northumberland (£487) are lower than the North East (£492) and England (£544).

Children, Education and Skills

In Northumberland 55.3% of pupils at the End of KS4 Achieving 5 or more A*-C Including English and Maths in 2015 which is lower than the North East (56.3%) but higher than the rest of England (53.5%). The proportion of people aged 16-64 with no qualifications in Northumberland (9%) is higher than in England (8.6%) but lower than the North East (10.4%).
