

NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA

Northumberland County Council hereby gives notice that Rothbury Parish Council, Cartington Parish Council, Thropton Parish Council and Whitton and Tosson Parish Council have submitted an application for the designation of a 'Neighbourhood Area' under Regulation 6 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

Rothbury Parish Council is a 'Relevant Body' for the purposes of Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning. The purpose of the application is to enable Rothbury Parish Council to undertake neighbourhood planning. The proposed Neighbourhood Area covers the entire Rothbury Parish Council, Cartington Parish Council, Thropton Parish Council and Whitton and Tosson Parish Council as shown on the map below.
