

## NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA

Northumberland County Council hereby gives notice that Morpeth Town Council in partnership with the Civil Parishes of Hebron, Hepscott, Mitford and Pegswood has submitted an application for the designation of a 'Neighbourhood Area' under Regulation 6 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

Morpeth Town Council is a 'Relevant Body' for the purposes of Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning. The purpose of the application is to enable Morpeth Town Council to undertake neighbourhood planning and in particular to prepare a neighbourhood development plan for the Parishes of Morpeth, Hebron, Hepscott, Mitford and Pegswood. The proposed neighbourhood area covers the entire Parishes of Morpeth, Hebron, Hepscott, Mitford and Pegswood as shown on the map below.
