Proposed No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions on B6345 West Thirston Cabinet Member: Glen Sanderson - Environment & Local Services

Purpose of Report

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of new No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions on the B6345 West Thirston Village.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the new No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) on the B6345 West Thirston Village be introduced.

Key Issues

- 1. There are issues with indiscriminate parking and resulting road safety visibility concerns.
- 2. These issues were raised by local residents to County Councillor Glen Sanderson
- 3. The decision to introduce a permanent Traffic Regulation Order is supported by County Councillor Sanderson and the Parish Council.

Background

Following concerns raised by local residents to their local County Councillor and Parish Council, regarding indiscriminate parking adjacent to an access onto the B6345 West Thirston village.

The residential access is particularly narrow and visibility is difficult accessing to and from. This is exacerbated with parked vehicles, particularly a peak times at the adjacent children's nursery.

NCC Officers discussed this issue in more detail with County Councillor Sanderson. As a result, it was decided to introduce a section of No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) across the access, thereby creating better visibility for all road users.

NCC Parking Services will be notified to carry out enforcement by their Officers

The area will be monitored by NCC Parking Services following the implementation of the scheme and report back any subsequent changes required.

Full details of the new restrictions are shown on the plan in Appendix A.

Notification of these changes will be advertised as part of the legal process of making this Permanent Traffic Regulation Order.

Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified of this new Traffic Regulation Order.
