#### **Introduction of No Waiting Restrictions in Beadnell Village**

#### **Purpose of Report**

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of new 'No Waiting' Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at specific locations in Beadnell Village.

#### **Recommendations**

It is recommended that the new 'No Waiting at Any Time' (Double Yellow Line) restrictions, on sections of the following locations: Benthall, Sandy Lane Court, Harbour Road and Longbeach Drive Beadnell be introduced.

#### **Key Issues**

1. There are issues with indiscriminate parking and resulting visibility concerns, particularly at junctions and on bends.
2. These additions are in response to concerns raised by the Parish Council.
3. The decision to introduce a permanent Traffic Regulation Order is supported by the relevant Parish Council and County Councillor Guy Renner-Thompson

### Background

Following concerns raised by local residents via their Local County Councillor and Beadnell Parish Council, several road safety issues have been highlighted, including poor visibility at junctions and indiscriminate parking.

This problem is exacerbated during the summer peak period when traffic flows are high, however, as with many coastal villages in Northumberland, it extends to most of the year. Restrictions were previously introduced (double yellow lines) in October 2019 in a number of key locations in Beadnell, following an experimental period, details of which can be found in the Decision Report - Introduction of No Waiting Restrictions Beadnell Village 9th October 2019, available on the NCC Website.

This matter was discussed between NCC Officers, County Councillor Renner-Thompson and Beadnell Parish Council. It was agreed to introduce an extension of the existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' (Double Yellow Line) restrictions. The new restrictions are supported by NCC Parking Services, who will carry out enforcement.

The new restrictions will include:

Extending the existing double yellow lines on:

- Benthall, eastwards to Harbour Road,
- Harbour Road, north from Benthall.

New double yellow lines on:

- Longbeach Drive north from Benthall
- At the junction of Sandy Lane Court and Longbeach Drive.

Full details of the new restrictions are shown on the plan in Appendix A.

Notification of these changes will be advertised as part of the legal process of making this Permanent Traffic Regulation Order.

Northumbria Police, other emergency services and relevant statutory consultees will be notified that this new Traffic Regulation Order.
