Proposed Speed Hump - Morwick Road/Guilden Road, Warkworth

Purpose of Report

To consider the introduction of a proposed speed hump on Morwick Road/Guilden Road, Warkworth.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the following traffic calming is introduced: Speed Hump.

Key Issues

- 1. Residents have raised concerns about vehicles using the road as a shortcut at high speeds.
- 2. The scheme is to be funded by Councillor Watson, through his Members' Local Improvement Scheme allowance.

Background

- 1. Residents contacted their local Ward member with concerns regarding vehicle speeds on Morwick Road/ Guilden Road, Warkworth.
- 2. Indiscriminate speed on the road is making it dangerous for pedestrians especially children walking to and from school.
- 3. After meeting with Councillor Watson, officers proposed that a speed hump be introduced in order to alleviate these concerns.
- 4. A consultation letter was sent to 2 residents on the proposed speed hump. A copy of the consultation letter and plan are attached in Appendix A.
- 3 responses were received as a result of the consultation letter, with 3 in favour 0 against and 0 neither for nor against the proposal. A summary of the responses is attached as Appendix B.
- 6. The results of the consultation were discussed with Councillor Watson, who agreed that the speed hump should be introduced.
- 7. The scheme is supported by Councillor Watson and funded through his Members' Local Improvement Scheme allocation.


I would urge you to take the opportunity to comment on this important matter as any decision taken will be based upon the responses received from residents who take time to return the consultation form.


