Introduction of 'No Waiting' Restrictions in Swansfield Park Road Alnwick

#### **Purpose of Report**

This report sets out the background to the proposed implementation of new 'No Waiting' Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at specific locations in Swansfield Park Road, Alnwick.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that the new 'No Waiting at Any Time' (Double Yellow Line) restrictions are introduced in Swansfield Park Road, Alnwick.

#### **Key Issues**

- 1. These restrictions are required to fulfil an outstanding planning condition.
- 2. These additions are in response to a request by NCC Education Department
- 3. The decision to introduce a permanent Traffic Regulation Order is supported by NCC Officers in Highways, Education and County Councillor Castle.

## Background

NCC Education Department (via NCC Planning) in order to fulfil an outstanding planning condition, made a request to the Highways Design Section. The brief was to provide a scheme design to fulfil this requirement.

A scheme to introduce 'No Waiting At Any Time' Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) was prepared. The aim is to introduce double yellow lines at the junction of Swansfield Park Road and Lindisfarne Road to ensure no parking takes place which would otherwise impede the required visibility splay.

Full details of the new restrictions are shown on the plan in Appendix A.

Notification of these changes will be advertised as part of the legal process of making this Permanent Traffic Regulation Order.
