Proposed Traffic Calming Measures – U8171 Garden House Bank, Acomb

Cabinet Member: Glen Sanderson - Leader of Council

### **Purpose of Report**

To consider the introduction Traffic Calming Measures – U8171 Garden House Bank, Acomb due to traffic safety concerns.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that Traffic Calming Measures are introduced on the U8171 Garden House Bank, Acomb.

### **Key Issues**

- Residents have raised safety concerns for both pedestrians and motorists caused by speeding traffic on Garden House Bank, Acomb
- 2. The scheme is supported by Cllr Cessford and the Local Parish Council.

### Background

Concerns have been raised by local residents with Councillor Cessford and the Parish Council about excessive vehicular speed and road safety on the Garden House Bank, Acomb. Which is currently used as a "short cut", to and from the A6079.

Given the concerns raised, speed surveys were undertaken and these have provided evidence that vehicles are exceeding the current 30mph speed limit. In addition to the fact that Garden House Bank is particularly narrow in places (see photo below), the NCC Design team in discussion with NCC Traffic Safety Offices, Councillor Cessford and the Parish Council have proposed the following scheme to include:

- 75mm high speed cushions.
- The introduction of a 20 MPH Speed Limit on Garden House Bank
- For consistency within Acomb the introduction of a 20 MPH Speed Limit in Redburn Crescent and Orchard Avenue, which also access the main A6079 through Acomb

It is anticipated that these proposed measures will provide a safer environment in this area for all road users.

This scheme will be programmed with a proposed resurfacing scheme in Acomb in early 2021. Thereby minimising disruption to for road users and providing economies of scale for the project.

### Consultation

The proposed scheme will be introduced due to the road safety concerns at this location. A formal consultation did not take place, however Councillor Cessford and the Parish Council carried out an extensive canvasing of the local residents of Acomb.

The scheme is supported by Councillor Cessford, the Parish Council and local residents and funded through 2020/21 LTP funds.
