Proposed Extension of 30 MPH Speed Limit Restriction on the B6525 Wooler

Purpose of Report

This report sets out the background to the proposed extension of the existing 30 MPH speed limit on the B6525 Berwick Road, east of the A697 Wooler.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the 30 MPH speed limit restriction on the B6535 east of the A697 Wooler Town is extended.

Key Issues

- 1. There is a requirement for the approval of planning application 19/02272/FUL to extend the 30 MPH speed limit restriction on the B6525 Berwick Road, Wooler.
- 2. This extension of the speed limit restriction is recommended to improve road safety.

Background

A planning application for the development and erection of a new Water Treatment Works adjacent to the B6525 Berwick Road, approximately 300 metres east of the A697 Wooler. A condition of this application is to provide visibility splays at the entrance to the new site and extend the existing 30 MPH speed limit restriction on this road. Thereby, encompassing the new development within this new speed restriction and with the aim to improve road safety for all road users.

Formal consultation with interested parties took place via Planning Application reference 19/02272/FUL, where full details may be obtained.
