PROPOSED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON DENE VIEW DRIVE & EDENDALE AVENUE, BLYTH

Purpose of Report

To consider the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time parking restrictions on Dene View Drive & Edendale Avenue in Blyth due to road safety concerns.

Recommendations

It is recommended that a "No Waiting at Any Time" (Double Yellow Lines) parking restriction is introduced on Dene View Drive & Edendale Avenue in Blyth.

Key Issues

- 1. Concerns have been raised with the local councillor about inconsiderate parking on Dene View Drive & Edendale Avenue in Blyth.
- 2. Vehicles are parking on the junction causing visibility problems.
- 3. Restriction are to be introduced without formal consultation in order to address road safety concerns raised by local residents.

Delegated Decision

 The scheme is supported by Councillor Richardson and will be paid for through Cllr Richardson's Members Local Improvement Scheme funding.

Background

- Vehicles are parking on the junction causing sightline problems for vehicles exiting these roads. This inconsiderate parking has raised road safety concerns that have been reported to the local county councillor.
- 2. The Highway Code states "DO NOT stop of park opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space". This is to allow sightlines to be kept clear.
- After discussing the complaints with the Local County Councillor it was agreed that double yellow lines should be introduced without any formal consultation due to the restrictions being necessary on road safety grounds.

Consultation

The introduction of No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines) parking restriction will be introduced without consultation due to road safety concerns in the area. The statutory consultees including the emergency services and various disabled and transport organisations/associations will be informed of the decision as well as the Chief Officer of Police. A plan showing the proposals is attached as Appendix A.

Recommendations

From the outset, the County Council has endeavoured to respond positively to local concerns raised in the this area and it is inevitable that some individuals in the community will be dissatisfied with whichever decision is reached. The introduction of parking restrictions without consultation can be a contentious matter, but due to the road safety concerns in the area and support from the Local County Councillor, it is recommended that the "No Waiting at Any Time" (double yellow lines) are introduced on Dene View Drive & Edendale Avenue, Blyth.


