Proposed Introduction of No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions on Percy Drive Amble

Purpose of Report

This report sets out the background to the proposed introduction of new No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions on Percy Drive Amble adjacent to a new private housing development.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the proposed No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) on Percy Drive, Amble are implemented.

Key Issues

- 1. The new restrictions are required to facilitate the flow of traffic adjacent to the new housing development
- 2. The scheme has been subject to full planning approval.

Background

The proposed introduction of a new no waiting restrictions are required following a planning application for a new private housing development adjacent to Percy Drive, Amble. The existing restrictions will no longer be appropriate due to the construction of this new estate and junction layout.

These proposals have been discussed and assessed by NCC Design and NCC Highway Improvements Team.

It is anticipated that the introduction of No Waiting restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at this location, will aid the anticipated increase flow of traffic and provide increased visibility at the junctions on this section of highway.

The construction works on site will commence in the new year (2022) via the planning application and will continue for a number of months.

The implementation of these restrictions are supported by NCC Parking Services, who will also carry out any enforcement necessary.

Full details of the proposed restrictions are detailed on plan in Appendix A.

These changes are a condition of a formal planning application.
