

STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The proposal is being considered for the removal of the existing 'No Waiting Tuesday and Friday 9am-5pm' restriction on Nent Grove, Maidens Walk and Rede Avenue in Hexham

The key issues are:

- The Department for Transport are urging Local Authorities to reduce sign clutter where possible. Taking away the time restriction will a number of signs from the network.
