

STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

B1334 Newbiggin Road, Ashington


The Order is necessary to improve road safety by prohibiting obstructive and indiscriminate parking at the junction of the B1334 Newbiggin Road and Norham Road in Ashington following carriageway narrowing works. Parked vehicles obscure visibility for pedestrians and motorists at the uncontrolled crossing point on the northern side of the B1334 Newbiggin Road at this junction and 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions are therefore required.
