Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Paragraphs 20 and 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 16th March 2020 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Central) Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 – Amendment No 36 Order 2020".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Central) Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011".

"Amendment Order" means "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Central) Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 – Amendment No 36 Order 2020".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

(B) Deletions



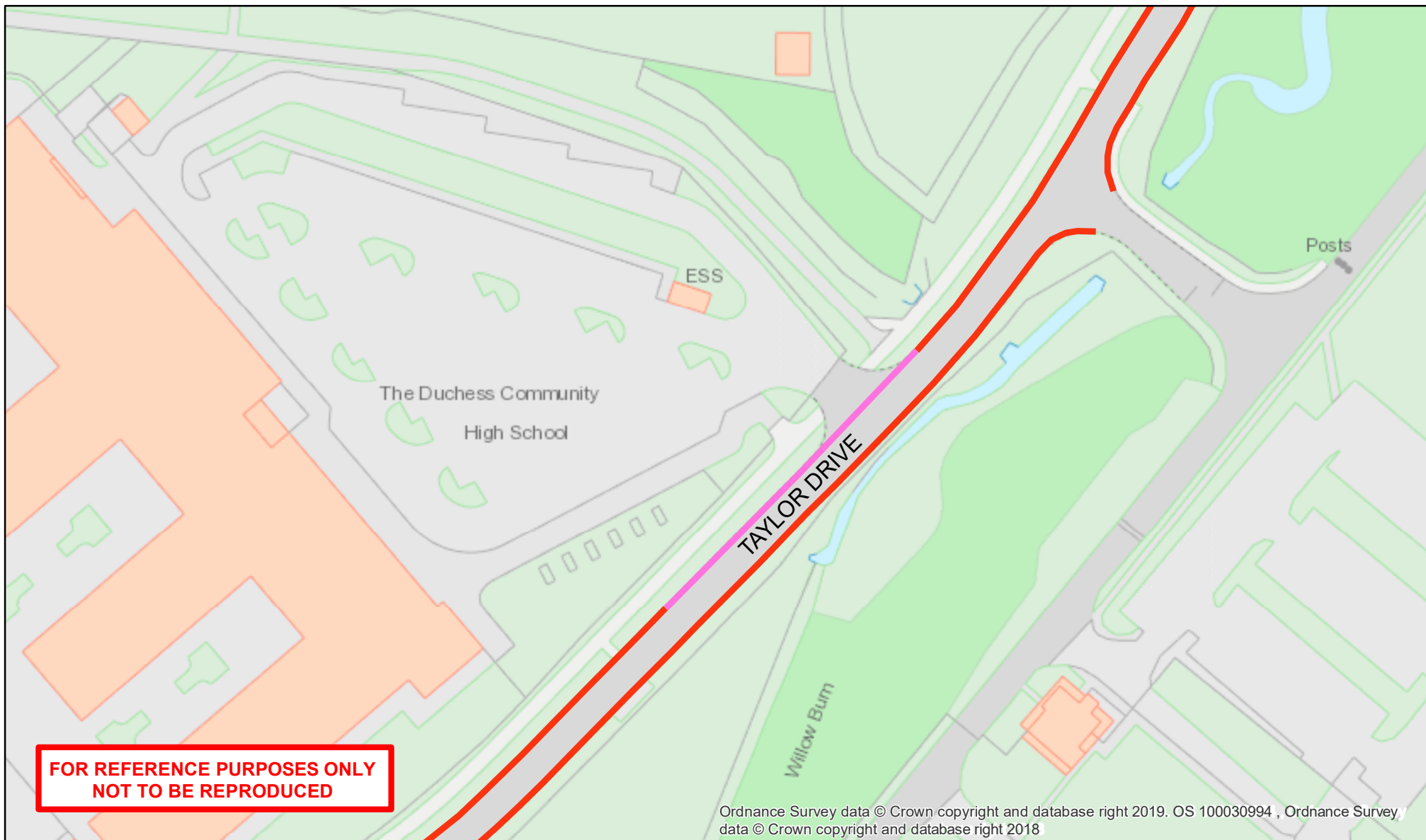

**STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR
PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER**

Duchess's Community High School, Taylor Drive, Alnwick

The proposed amendments to the 'School Keep Clear' restrictions on Taylor Drive are required as a result of the development of The Duchess's Community High School Alnwick and to reflect the same restriction times as the other existing markings across the County. They are to be introduced in order to aid the flow of traffic and safety on the approaches to the new school.
