<div><div>1.</div><div>To operate specialist heavy plant to undertake a variety of construction works across Northumberland. Load associated vehicles.</div></div> <div><div>2.</div><div>Manage and maintain the plant and equipment in line with manufacturers guidance.</div></div> <div><div>3.</div><div>Advise operational teams of the operational risk associated with the plant and equipment.</div></div> <div><div>4.</div><div>Liaise with the fleet department for replacement parts and equipment as and when required.</div></div> <div><div>5.</div><div>Adhere to all Health and Safety Method Statements, COSHH Assessments, Risk Assessments and Procedures and have working knowledge of Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual which covers signing and guarding at roadworks. Be competent in the use of all personal protection equipment such as ear and eye protectors, high visibility clothing, etc.</div></div> <div><div>6.</div><div>Location of underground services using a cable locator and public utility service drawings and plans prior to excavation. Excavate with extreme care in the vicinity of live public utility service cables and pipes.</div></div> <div><div>7.</div><div>Be aware of and comply with Health and Safety Regulations and Requirements and attend safety courses as necessary to obtain accreditation / certification.</div></div> <div><div>8.</div><div>Capable by means of training and accreditation to drive construction plant and machinery such as road rollers and mini excavators with front and rear shovel.</div></div> <div><div>9.</div><div>Day to day driving and security of vehicles and plant such as excavators, light pickups, vans and LGV's.</div></div> <div><div>10.</div><div>Snow clearing and gritting with specialist plant and hand tools.</div></div> <div><div>11.</div><div>The ability to use a loading shovel and other highways equipment e.g. small vibrating rollers, compactors, stihl saws, compressors etc.</div></div> <div><div>12.</div><div>To be able to work from written works instructions where no direct supervision is available also read and interpret construction and utility drawings and carry out simple site setting out procedures.</div></div> <div><div>13.</div><div>Occasional supervision and on site training of trainees / YTS.</div></div> <div><div>14.</div><div>Excavation of trenches taking all necessary health and safety precautions including shoring.</div></div> <div><div>15.</div><div>To complete vehicle and plant log sheets and weekly time sheets for costing purposes.</div></div> <div><div>16.</div><div>Responsible for security of items of plant and machinery while working on site.</div></div> <div><div>17.</div><div>Willing to respond to out of hours calls to make safe dangerous situations e.g. oil spillage, road traffic accident, etc.</div></div> <div><div>18.</div><div>Occasional on-the-job training of new recruits</div></div> <div><div>19.</div><div>Training will be made available for duties as applicable to the post.</div></div> <div><div>20.</div><div>It is expected that the post-holder will work in a way which furthers the values of the organisation, with particular reference to customer care, equal access and opportunity and quality of service.</div></div>
