Definitive Map Modification Order (No 5) 2022

Byway Open to All Traffic No 13 Restricted Byway No 15 (Parish of Kilham)

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) and (iii), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 June 2022.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 5) 2022.

Description of Modification to Definitive Map and Statement

Former Berwick-upon-Tweed Borough

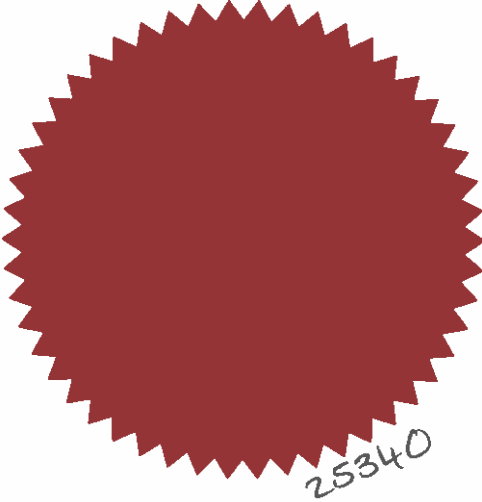
Kilham	Byway Open to All Traffic No 13	(NT 82 NE)
Part I	Map:	Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked A, at the southern end of existing Byway Open to All Traffic No 13, 480 metres north of Elsdonburn Shank, in a general southerly direction, along the route of the U1017 road / existing Footpaths Nos 5 and 3, for a distance of 495 metres, via a point marked B, to a point marked X, at the entrance to Elsdonburn Shank.
Part II	Statement:	To be amended as follows: A 6.4 metre wide byway open to all traffic, incorporating a 2.5 to 2.8 metre wide tarmac track, from a point on the U1017 road, 20 metres south-east of Longknowe, in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 435 metres, to a gateway just south of Thompsons Walls, thereafter as a 4.57 metre wide byway open to all traffic, incorporating a 2.1 to 2.2 metre wide tarmac track, in a general south-westerly direction, for a distance of 505 metres, then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 155 metres, then in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 190 metres to a point 480 metres north of Elsdonburn Shank, thereafter as a 6.4 metre wide byway open to all traffic in a southerly direction for a distance of 30 metres, thereafter as a 4.57 metre wide byway open to all traffic, in a southerly direction for a further 335 metres, then in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 115 metres to Elsdonburn Shank, then in a westerly direction for 15 metres, to a junction with Restricted Byway No 15, at the entrance to Elsdonburn Shank.
Kilham	Restricted Byway No 15	(NT 82 NE)
Part I	Map:	Adding thereto a restricted byway, from a point marked X, at the entrance to Elsdonburn Shank, in a westerly direction along the U1017 road for a distance of 12 metres, to a point marked Y, on existing Footpath No 3, level with the north facing gable end of that property.

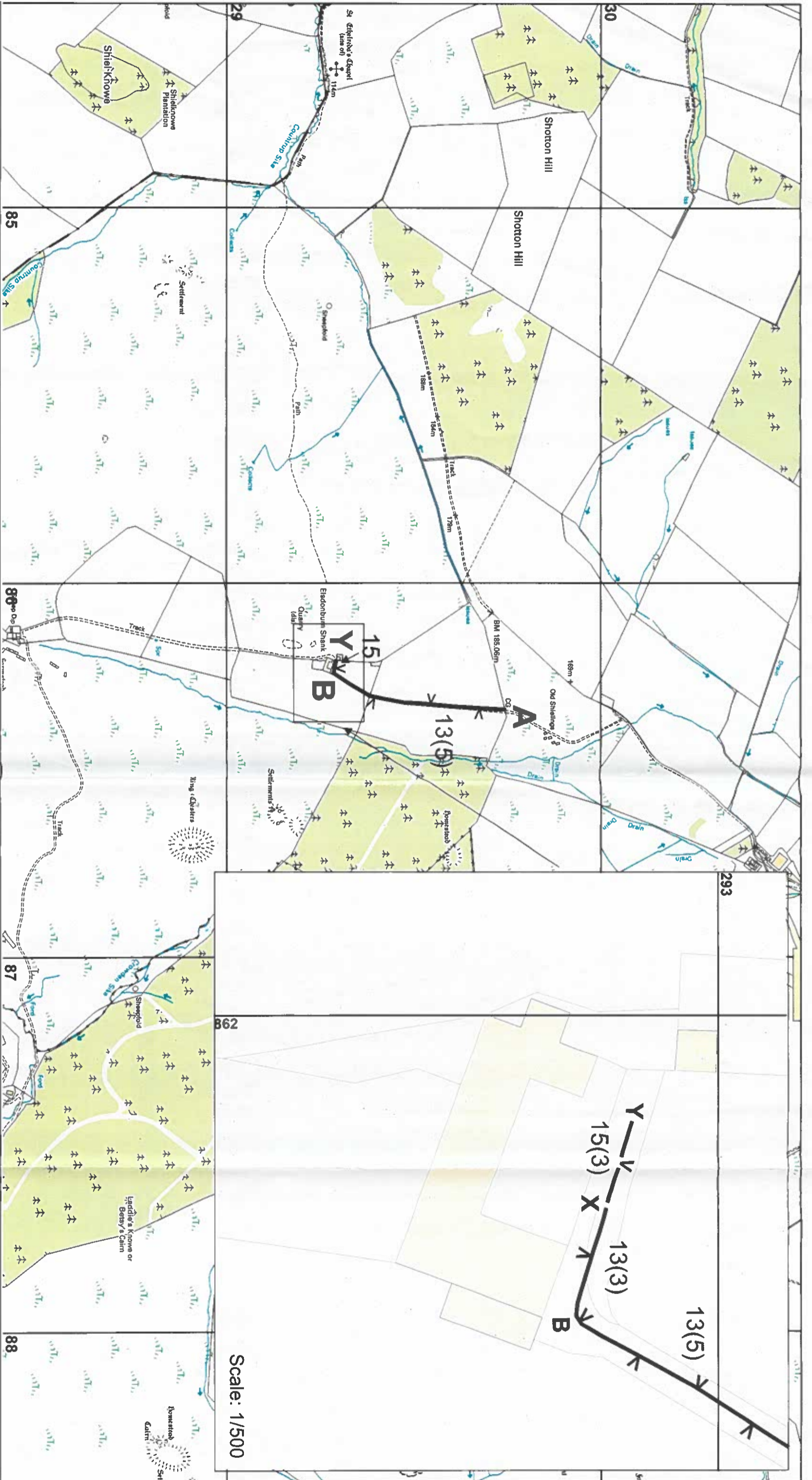
