Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2024

Public Footpaths Nos 5 and 50 (Morpeth Town)

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

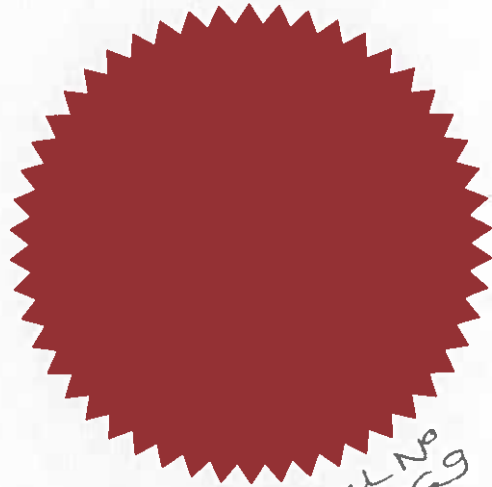
The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 April 2024.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2024.

Description of Modification to Definitive Map and Statement

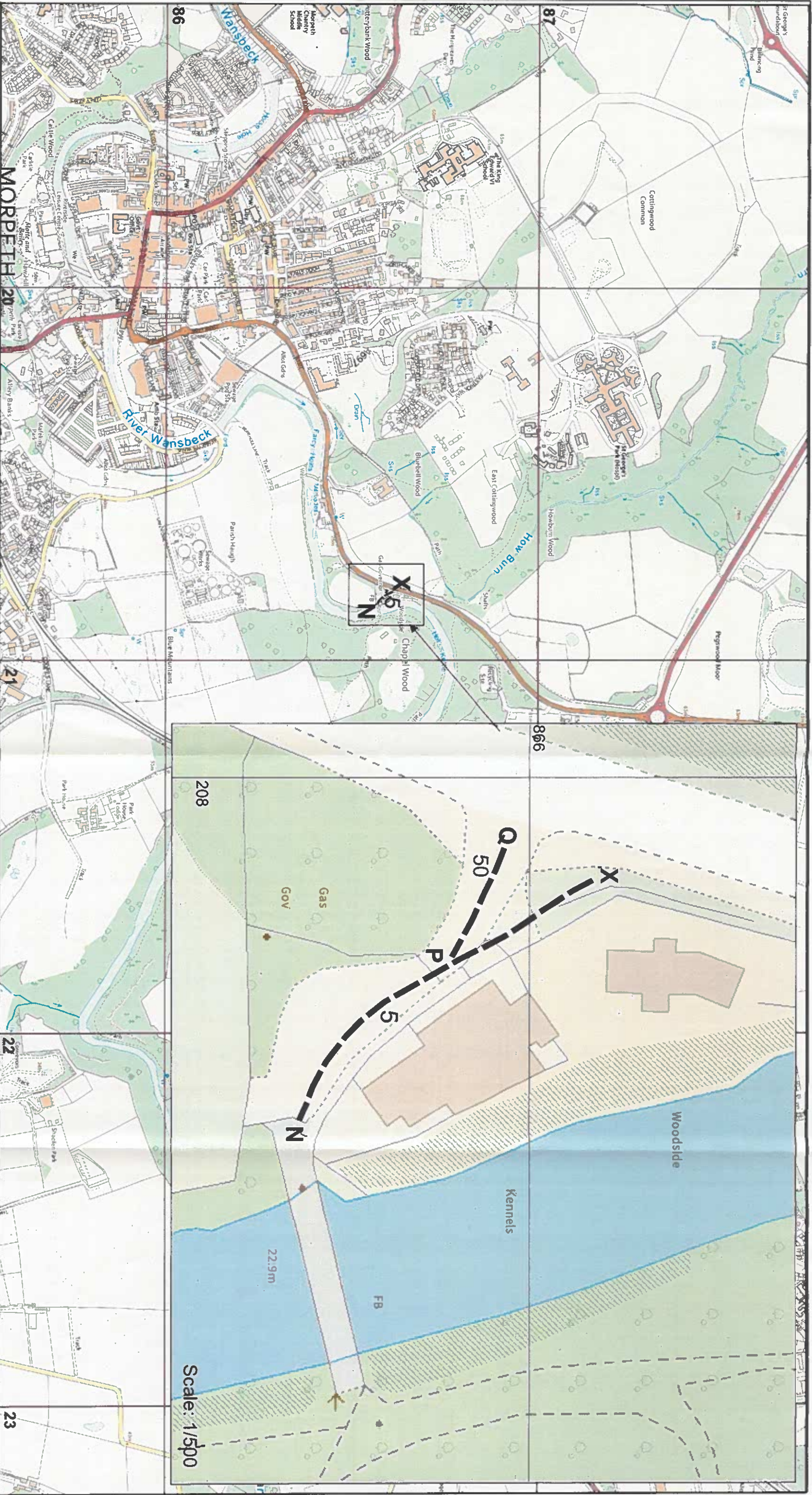
Morpeth	Footpath No 5	(NZ 28 NW)
Part I	Map:	Adding thereto a public footpath, from a point marked X, on the B1337 (Morpeth – Ashington) road, on Whorral Bank, 10 metres west of Woodside, in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres, via a point marked P, to a point marked N, at the existing western end of Public Footpath No 5, at the western end of a bridge over the River Wansbeck.
Part II	Statement:	To be amended as follows: As a 5 to 10 metre wide footpath, from the B1337 (Morpeth – Ashington) road, 10 metres west of Woodside, in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres to the western end of a bridge over the River Wansbeck. Thereafter as a 0.61 to 3.05 metre wide path, in a general south-easterly direction, crossing the River Wansbeck by a footbridge and the former L.N.E. Railway, past the west side of Park House to the former Borough boundary at Coopie's Lane.
Morpeth	Footpath No 50	(NZ 28 NW)
Part I	Map:	Adding thereto a public footpath, from a point marked Q, on the B1337 (Morpeth – Ashington) road, on Whorral Bank, 20 metres south-west of Woodside, in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres, to a point marked P, on the alleged extension of Public Footpath No 5, 20 metres south of Woodside.
Part II	Statement:	To be prepared as follows: As an 8.2 to 9.5 metre wide footpath, from the B1337 (Morpeth – Ashington) road, on Whorral Bank, 20 metres south-west of Woodside, in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres, to join Public Footpath No 5, 20 metres south of Woodside.
