## **Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland**

### **The Northumberland County Council**

#### **Definitive Map Modification Order (No 7) 2020**

##### **Byway Open to All Traffic No 34 and Public Bridleway No 20 (Parish of Harbottle)**

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i)+(iii) namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 July 2020.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 7) 2020.

#### Description of Modification to Definitive Map and Statement

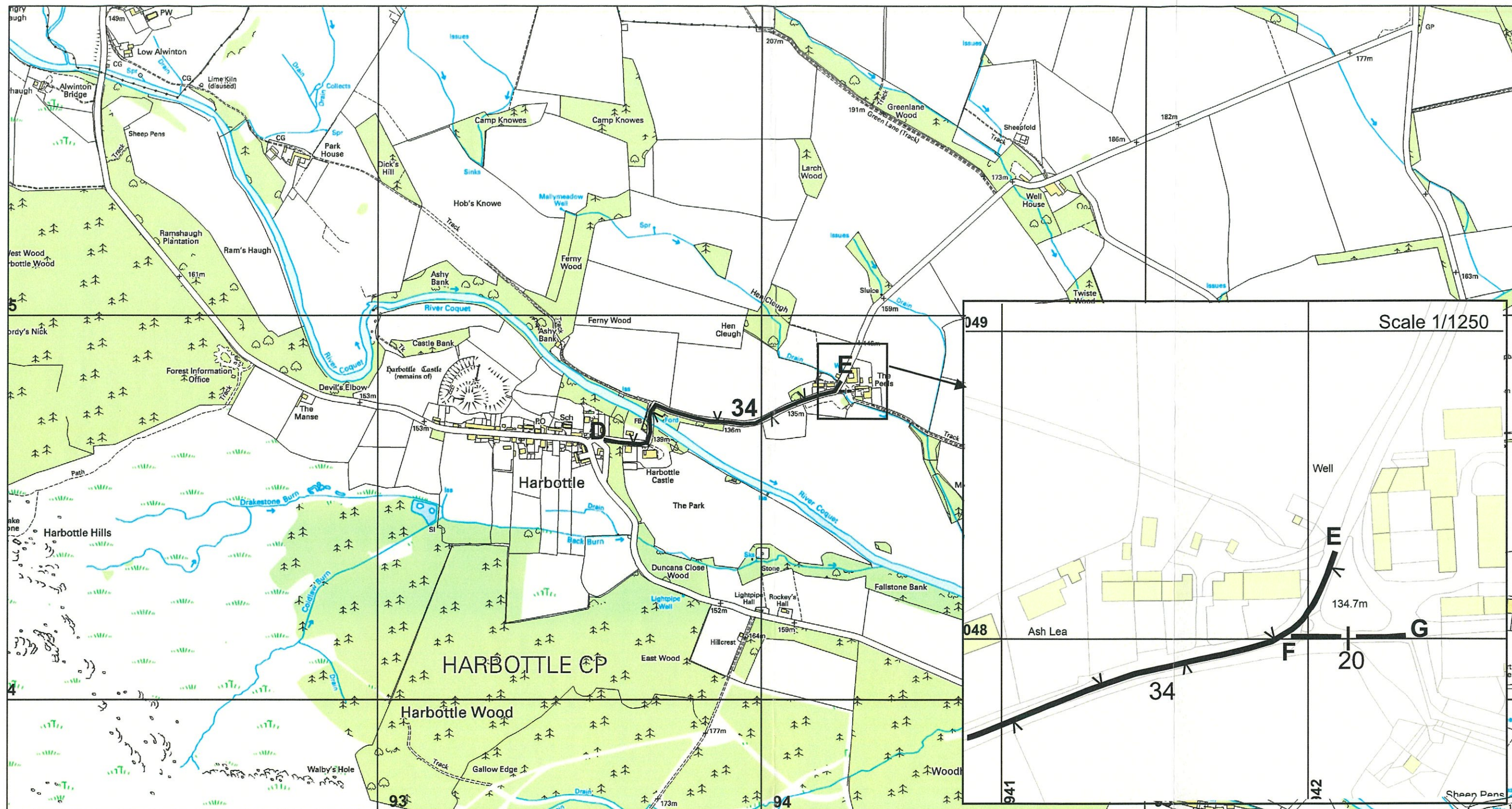
##### Former Alnwick District

<b>Harbottle</b>		<b>Byway Open to All Traffic No 34</b>	<b>(NT 90 SW)</b>
Part I	Map:	Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked D, on the U4018 road, 15 metres south of <del>Garden</del> Cottage, Harbottle, in a general easterly direction along the U4018 road for a distance of 750 metres, to a point marked E, on the U4018 road, 10 metres north-east of number <del>1</del> Peels Cottages.	
Part II	Statement:	To be prepared as follows: As a 6.5 to 7 metre wide byway, from a point on the U4018 road, 15 metres south of <del>Garden</del> Cottage, Harbottle, in an easterly direction for a distance of 125 metres, then northerly direction for a distance of 20 metres. Thereafter as a 5.5 to 6 metre wide byway continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 30 metres to a ford through the River Coquet. As a 5 metre wide byway in a northerly direction through the River Coquet for a distance of 30 metres, then as a 4.5 metre wide byway in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres to a junction with the eastern end of Public Bridleway No 11. Thereafter as a 7 to 8.5 metre wide byway in an easterly direction for a distance of 275 metres, then north-easterly direction for a distance of 130 metres. Thereafter as a 6.5 to 7 metre wide byway in a easterly direction for a distance of 90 metres, then as a 5 metre wide byway in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres to a point on the U4018 road, 10 metres north-east of number <del>1</del> Peels Cottages.	
<b>Harbottle</b>		<b>Bridleway No 11</b>	<b>(NT 90 SW)</b>
Part I	Map:	The map is not affected.	
Part II	Statement:	To be amended as follows: From Bridleway No 41 in the Parish of Alwinton at that Parish Boundary in a south-easterly direction by Park House and Peels Cottage to join Byway Open to All Traffic No 34 (the Harbottle - Peels road) north of the bridge over the River Coquet.	

<b>Harbottle</b>	<b>Footpath No 19</b>	<b>(NT 90 SW)</b>
Part I	Map:	The map is not affected.
Part II	Statement:	To be amended as follows: From Byway Open to All Traffic No 34 (the Harbottle-Peels road) east of Harbottle in a south-easterly direction to join Bridleway No 20 south-east of Peels.

<b>Harbottle</b>	<b>Bridleway No 20</b>	<b>(NT 90 SW)</b>
Part I	Map:	Adding thereto a public bridleway, from a point marked F on alleged Byway Open to All Traffic No 34 (the U4018 road), 70 metres west of The Peels Farmhouse, in an easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres, to a point marked G, at the existing western end of Public Bridleway No 20, 30 metres west of The Peels Farmhouse.
Part II	Statement:	To be amended as follows: As a 3 metre wide bridleway, from Byway Open to All Traffic No 34 (the Harbottle - Peels road) at Peels, in an easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres. Thereafter as a path, in a south-easterly direction crossing Peels Haugh and the River Coquet to a point on the south bank of the river, 360 metres north of Wood Hall Farm. Thereafter as a 3 metre wide path, in a south-easterly direction, for a distance of 420 metres to join the C172 road, 125 metres south-west of the point where that road crosses the River Coquet.

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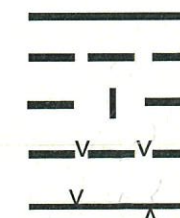
