
This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) and (iii), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 June 2024.
- 2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 9) 2024.

Description of Modification to Definitive Map and Statement

Bridleway / Footpath No 29

Map:

Upgrading thereto to public bridleway status, existing Public Footpath No 29, from a point marked Q, on the C141 road, 25 metres north of High Southward Edge, in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 2030 metres, to a point marked R, on the C139 road, 450 metres pourth of Musckley Form

the C138 road, 450 metres south of Muckley Farm.

Part II Statement:

To be amended as follows:

A 6.5 metre wide bridleway, from the C141 road, 25 metres north of High Southward Edge, in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres through the garden of that property. Thereafter as a 6.5 to 9.14 metre wide bridleway, in an easterly then south-easterly direction for a distance of 350 metres. Then as a 14 to 16 metre wide bridleway in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres. Thereafter as an 18.29 to 20.7 metre wide bridleway in an easterly then south-easterly direction for 750 metres. Thereafter as an 18.29 to 26.8 metre wide bridleway in an easterly direction for 320 metres. Then as a 14 to 17.6 metre wide bridleway in an easterly direction for 430 metres. Thereafter as a 12.19 to 14 metre wide bridleway in an easterly direction for 130 metres, to join the C138 road, 450 metres south of Muckley Farm.
