Northumberland County Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way For the County of Northumberland

Definitive Map Modification Order (No 10) 2022

The above Order, made on 21st October 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Former Alnwick District

Adding thereto a public footpath, from the (old) Alnwick Road, between Alnbrig and Brockgate Lodge (O.S. Grid Ref NU 2324 1168), in an easterly, then northerly, direction for a distance of 90 metres, to the western end of the Lealands Estate road, immediately west of number 3 Lealands (NU 2330 1173).

These details are shown on the Order map. If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Northumberland County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
