Northumberland County Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way For the County of Northumberland

Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2022

The above Order, made on 15th July 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Former Berwick-upon-Tweed Borough

Restricted Byway No 14 and Footpath No 4 (Parish of Kilham)

Adding thereto a restricted byway, from the C33 road, at the Scottish border, north of Yetholm Mains (O.S. Grid Ref NT 8400 2984), in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 280 metres, to a point 280 metres east of Yetholm Mains (NT 8421 2967), and upgrading thereto to restricted byway status (and renumbering) part of existing Public Footpath No 4, from this point 280 metres east of Yetholm Mains, in a south-easterly then general easterly direction for a distance of 3680 metres, to join existing Public Bridleway No 6 and Public Footpath No 5, in the Parish of Kirknewton (NT 8747 2968).

Footpath No 5 & Bridleway No 6 (Parish of Kirknewton)

The Definitive Statements for these existing public rights of way will be amended to reflect the addition of the 'new' Restricted Byway No 14.

These details are shown on the Order map. A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Council Offices of Berwick Library, Walkergate, Berwick-upon-Tweed, TD15 1DB and the offices of Legal Services, County Hall, Morpeth, NE61 2EF during normal working hours. Any representations or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Neil Masson, Legal Services Senior Manager, at the address shown below no later than **22nd September 2022**. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Northumberland County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
