## **Definitive Map Modification Order (No 6) 2024**

The above Order, made on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

## **Former Castle Morpeth Borough**

#### **Public Footpath No 5 (Morpeth Town)**

Adding thereto a public footpath, from the B1337 (Morpeth – Ashington) road, on Whorral Bank, 10 metres west of Woodside (O.S. Grid Ref NZ 2081 8661), in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres, to the existing western end of Public Footpath No 5, at the western end of a bridge over the River Wansbeck (NZ 2084 8656).

#### Public Footpath No 50 (Morpeth Town)

Adding thereto a public footpath, from the B1337 (Morpeth – Ashington) road, on Whorral Bank, 20 metres south-west of Woodside (O.S. Grid Ref NZ 2081 8659), in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres, to join the alleged extension of Public Footpath No 5, 20 metres south of Woodside (NZ 2082 8658).
