Northumberland County Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way For the County of Northumberland

Definitive Map Modification Order (No 18) 2024

The above Order, made on 13th November 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Former Tynedale District

Public Bridleway No 31 (Parish of Kirkwhelpington)

Adding thereto a public bridleway, from the C195 road, 180 metres south-east of East White Hill (O.S. Grid Ref NY 9946 8581), in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 310 metres, to the existing northern end of Public Bridleway No 31, 105 metres east of Middle Whitehill (NY 9957 8557).

These details are shown on the Order map. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
