

## **Notice of Public Path Order**

### **Town and Country Planning Act 1990, Section 257 and Paragraph 1 of Schedule 14 Northumberland County Council**

#### **Alnwick Town (Public Footpath No 32) Diversion Order 2022**

The above Order was made on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022. The effect of the Order will be as follows:-

#### **Public Footpath No 32 (Alnwick Town)**

To extinguish the footpath, from a point 25 metres north-east of number 170 Allerburn Lea (OS grid ref: NU 1988 1315), in an easterly direction for a distance of 140 metres, then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 250 metres, to a point 25 metres north of number 31 Somerset Avenue (NU 2022 1302).

To create a 2 metre wide footpath, from a point 25 metres north-east of number 170 Allerburn Lea (OS grid ref: NU 1988 1315), in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 100 metres, then in a southerly direction for a distance of 85 metres, then in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 245 metres, then in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres to a point 25 metres north of number 31 Somerset Avenue (NU 2022 1302).

These details are shown on the Order map. A copy of the Order and map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council Offices of Alnwick Information Centre, Greenwell Lane, Alnwick, NE66 1HB and at Main Reception, County Hall, Morpeth, NE61 2EF, during normal working hours. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
