Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981**

Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way  
For the County of Northumberland**

**Definitive Map Modification Order (No 7) 2022**

The above Order, made on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2022, was confirmed on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023 and will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

**Former Alnwick District**

**Byway Open to All Traffic No 28 (Parish of Whittingham)**

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a crossroads of the U4009 and U4010 roads, immediately north-west of West Lodge, Eslington (O.S. Grid Ref NU 0386 1169), in a general southerly direction along part of the U4010 road for a distance of 305 metres, to join the C172 road, 25 metres north-west of Eslington Highhill (NU 0391 1140).

These details are shown on the Order map. A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Council Offices of Greenwell Lane, Greenwell Road, Alnwick, NE66 1HB and the offices of Legal Services, County Hall, Morpeth, NE61 2EF during normal working hours. The Order became operative on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any regulation has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may, within six weeks from 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023 make an application to the High Court for that purpose.
