Does your business comply with the law?

- Do you minimise your waste using the waste hierarchy which recommends this order of preference;- prevent, reuse, recycle, recover and dispose?
- Have you made arrangements for your waste disposal with a waste contractor who is registered to collect waste?
- Can you demonstrate that you never put your business waste in a household bin, never in a litter bin, and never take it to a Household Waste Recovery Centre?
- Do you store your waste appropriately?
- Can you demonstrate you are fully compliant (including holding valid Waste Transfer Notes)?

Did you know that...

since January 2015, businesses are required to separate waste for recycling (paper, plastic, metals and glass) wherever it is Technically, Environmentally or Economically Practicable (T.E.E.P).

If you only use one container for recyclables and non-recyclables then you are unlikely to comply.

How can the council help you meet this obligation?

- We offer co-mingled collections for paper, card, cans, aerosols and plastic bottles.
- We offer a separate collection for glass (subject to location).
- We use your non-recyclables as a fuel to make electricity.
