Glass Recycling Trial

At Northumberland County Council we are always looking at ways to improve our services – and many people have asked us if we can collect glass waste from homes, as you currently cannot place it in your household recycling bin.

We now want to try out a new glass recycling service, and your home has been selected as one of around 4,000 across the county for a 12-month trial.

Glass is one of the only materials which can be recycled again and again, and recycling more will also help us in our commitment to tackling climate change in Northumberland.

What will happen next?

• In the next 10 days we will deliver you a new small grey wheeled bin with a purple lid to put your glass in, around half the size of a normal wheeled bin.

- Put all your glass bottles and jars of any colour in this bin, rinsed first please.
- We will collect the glass every four weeks, on the dates on the calendar on the front of this letter. Please put your bin at the kerbside by 7am on the day of collection, with the bin handle facing the road.
- Please sign up for electronic reminders of your collection day at www.northumberland. gov.uk/glass or phone 0345 600 6400. If you sign up for electronic reminders, you'll also be entered into a prize draw to win £100 voucher.
- Continue to use your other bins as normal. You can recycle plastic bottles, cardboard and paper, drinks cans, food tins and aerosols in your household recycling bin.
- Help us to review the service by completing a short survey halfway through, then at the end of the trial period.

Please check your collection calendar carefully as your glass waste collection day may be different to your general waste and recycling collections.
