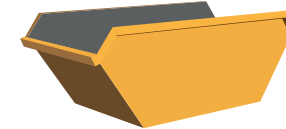

Is your waste disposal route in compliance with The Waste (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2011?

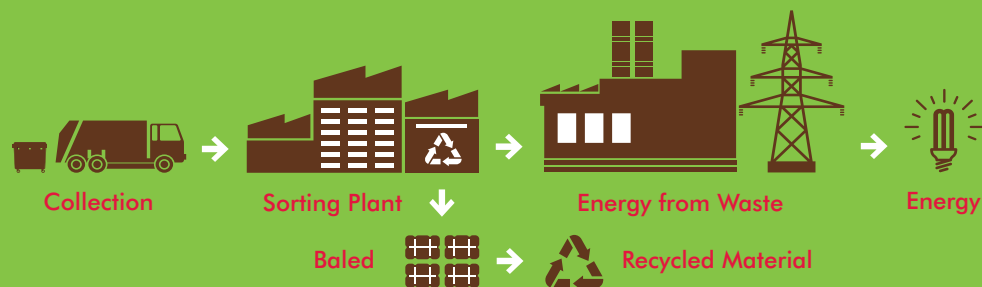
The regulations introduced on 1st January 2015 require the separate collection of paper, plastic, metals & glass for recycling from household and commercial waste. These materials must be collected separately if it is necessary to provide high quality recyclates; or it is technically, environmentally or economically practicable ('TEEP'). Businesses with only one bin for both recycling and general waste are unlikely to be meeting the requirements of the new Regulations.

The Council meets this obligation by providing:

- A co-mingled collection for paper, cardboard, cans and plastic bottles to recover high quality recyclates,
- A separate collection of glass (subject to your location) that is re-melted back into glass products or crushed and reused,
- A separate collection of all other waste that cannot be recycled which is burned to generate electricity,
- Help for you in your legal obligation to take reasonable measures to apply the waste hierarchy to prevent waste.

How do we carry out this service?

- We collect it at an agreed time, date and location.
- We take the recyclate to a Material Recycling Facility (MRF) to be sorted and baled ready for dispatch to the reprocessors.
- We take the un-recyclable to an Energy From Waste (EfW) plant, where it is burnt to create energy which feeds into the national grid.



What services are offered?

- Fully co-mingled recycling collection service which reduces the number of containers you need and keeps your costs to a minimum.

Mixed recycling (co-mingled collection)



Cardboard, paper, catalogues, magazines and envelopes.

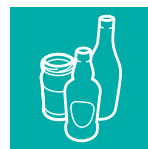


Food and drinks cans and aerosols.



Plastic bottles, without lids.

Glass collection, collected separately from co-mingled.



Any colour or clear glass is remelted or crushed for reuse (service subject to your location)

General waste collection, collected separately from co-mingled.



Non-recyclable rubbish collected is sent to an Energy from Waste plant to make electricity which feeds into the National Grid. Little or no waste is sent to landfill.
