

Rapid Response Funding for Training

Rapid Response Service (RRS) provides support to people affected by redundancy or other workforce management measures.

If you

- are under notice of redundancy
- have recently been made redundant

The decision to fund training, in every case, is based on whether it will improve your prospects of finding work:

- Short job focused training must be linked to your current or previous job roles
- Training must remove a barrier to employment or self employment
- Must be linked to vacancies in the local labour market that require these skills
- If you have existing skills that will move you into a job where there are vacancies then we are less likely to fund training

How to access funding:

- 13 weeks before redundancy (when under notice)
- Up to 13 weeks after being made redundant
- Undertake an individual Skills Transfer Analysis with the National Careers Service to discuss the options available to you
- You must ensure that you have all the relevant information available when you attend your appointment with the National Careers Service
