

NEWBIGGIN BAY CONDITIONS OF VEHICLE ACCESS

1. Persons using any vehicle on the beach are advised to have a minimum 3rd party insurance for their vehicle and trailers. All persons accessing the beach with a vehicle will be personally responsible for any loss or damage to their own equipment, vehicles, trailers and other Bay, beach and water users and their equipment and craft, whilst using the beach and Bay. The Council shall be kept fully and effectively indemnified against all claims that may arise through the operation of all vehicles on the beach.
2. Annual registration vehicle permits must be obtained before accessing the beach.
3. Persons accessing the beach with a vehicle MUST NOT:
 - Interfere with other beach and water users, or cause a deliberate nuisance to them.
 - Leave vehicle on the beach, or drive any said vehicle on the beach other than to collect Sea coal or seaweed as permitted by the free holders, DEFFRA and the authority.
 - Driving a motor vehicle on the beach other than to launch or retrieve a craft or to go about any agreed activity, is an offence under Section 34 of the 1988 Road Traffic Act, and will be dealt with through the police.
 - Leave their tractor and/or trailer on the beach other than in an area set aside for tractors and trailers.
4. To protect the Environment of the Bay and its users, it is prohibited to:
 - Deposit rubbish or pollutants of any description within the Bay or on the beaches, promenade slipways or access points.
 - Operate any machinery on the beach in the vicinity of the launch ramps, interfering with the easy access to and from the ramps and hampering any launch or recovery operations.
 - Remove sand or stones from the beach other than in accordance with the freehold rights, or under licence from Natural England
5. All registration Numbers, markers, stickers and permits must be displayed or produced on demand for inspection by an authorised representative of the Authority, Newbiggin town council, Freeholders, their agents or authorised members of partner organisations.
6. All persons using the bay shall be bound to observe and comply with any bye-laws for the prevention of danger, obstruction or annoyance of other beach and water users which shall be for the time being in force and all other provisions made by or under statute which for the time being applicable to the person boat/craft or vehicle registered in this scheme.
7. The Council shall reserve the right to suspend or revoke Vehicle access Permits whenever they deem it necessary or desirable in the interests of the public. Such suspension or revocation shall however except in a case of urgent public interest or necessity only be made after due notice has been given in writing.

Having read the foregoing conditions I HEREBY UNDERTAKE AND AGREE to fully observe the same and to be fully bound thereby and HEREBY INDEMNIFY the Council against all claims demands or expenses which might arise in connection with the operation of any craft or launch vehicles owned or operated by me.
