



Additional Restrictions Grant (Taxi V2)

To support self-employed taxi drivers within Northumberland as a contribution to continued fixed costs, a one-off payment of £200 is being made available to self-employed licensed taxi and private hire drivers, subject to certain conditions.

Who is eligible for the Grant

This one-off grant payment is being made available to specific self-employed taxi and private hire drivers licensed by Northumberland County Council. To be eligible for the grant drivers must be self-employed and have been licensed by Northumberland County Council on 18 September 2020.

Grant level

A one-off payment of £200 is available to eligible applicants.

How to Apply for the Additional Restrictions Grant (Taxi V2)

The Additional Restrictions Grant (Taxi V2) must be applied for by means of an online application form, [available on Northumberland County Council's website here](#).

The online form guides self-employed drivers through the application process and prompts applicants for the information required, as well any supporting documents needed (see 'Evidence to support application' below).

Evidence to Support Applications

Drivers are required to submit the following evidence to support their application:

- Name of applicant / licensed driver

- Northumberland County Council driver licence number
- Bank details in the driver's name must be provided (payment will not be made to a 3rd party bank account) and a copy of the last 3 bank statements
- National Insurance Number
- Applicants will need to confirm they are self-employed and do not receive a salary from an employer through the PAYE scheme
- Applicants will need to certify that they are not bankrupt, nor have they received a Statutory Demand or Bankruptcy Petition since 18th September 2020

Timescales for Applications

Applications for the Additional Restrictions Grant (Taxi V2) will open on 18 December 2020 and close at midnight on Sunday 3 January 2021.

Variation to the fund

The Council reserves the right to close or vary the terms of the scheme at any time, and without notice, should it be necessary to do so.

Appeals

There is no appeal process. Applicants whose applications are rejected may request a review. The review will be carried out by an officer who was not involved in the original decision. The decision of the review is final. Details about how to request a review will be provided to every applicant whose application is rejected.

Managing the risk of fraud

Neither the Government nor Northumberland County Council will accept deliberate manipulation and fraud - and any business caught falsifying their records to gain grant money will face prosecution and any funding issued will be subject to claw back, as may any grants paid in error.

It is important that applicants ensure that they provide accurate bank details for grant payments and that these relate to the business concerned.
