One day there was a meeting with lots of people. They all thought very hard about Joe and Hannah



They decided that it was not safe for Joe and Hannah to live with their mammy and daddy.

They decided that Joe and Hannah should have a new family who they could live with forever.

Laura went to court to speak to the judge who also agreed that they should have a new family.




Laura and another social worker looked very hard to find Joe and Hannah a new family who could keep them safe and happy.

Joe missed his birth Mammy and Daddy but knew that they could write to his new family and they would write back to them every year.




This meant that they could keep in contact and know each other were safe and happy.
