We would like to offer all students the opportunity to take part in the Arts Award programme as part of their ensemble membership this year. Students can apply to complete Bronze or if they have already received this award they can move onto Silver. Bronze is equivalent to level 1 national qualification and Silver level 2

Arts Award improves artistic skills and encourages creativity

Arts Award has a positive impact on young people's creativity. Young people understand creativity widely, from being able to make something of their own and solving problems, to writing their own opinions in a review.



Nurtures life skills

More than 80% of young people reported that Arts Award had a positive impact on their communication and people skills, such as leading a project, working in a group, and sharing opinions and listening to others.

For Bronze Arts Award, students will create a portfolio evidencing their participation in arts activities. The approximate amount of time needed to complete the portfolio is 40 hours, but much of that would be covered by their own lessons and ensemble activity.

For Silver Arts Award, students will be asked to plan and achieve a personal challenge. Alongside this, they will find out more about their chosen artform. They will be asked to plan and carry out an arts project or lead arts sessions. The approximate amount of time needed to complete this portfolio is 60 hours.
