

Child Sexual Exploitation Newsletter 2018

This newsletter on Child Sexual Exploitation aims to update you on our understanding of Child Sexual Exploitation which has improved due to research and serious case reviews over the last year. The NSCB wants to ensure that we are able to safeguard children and young people at the earliest point so that appropriate services can be provided to ensure these vulnerable people remain safe.

What do Serious Case Reviews tell us about Child Sexual Exploitation?

Case reviews highlight that child sexual exploitation can be particularly hard for professionals to recognise and respond to. Confusion around young people's rights and their capacity to consent to sexual activity means both young people and professionals often wrongly view exploitative relationships as consensual. This means that sexual exploitation often goes unidentified, and young people can be reluctant to engage with services.
