


Young Carer Pledge

Example: I want my school to understand I am a young carer and that sometimes I might have trouble doing my homework at home



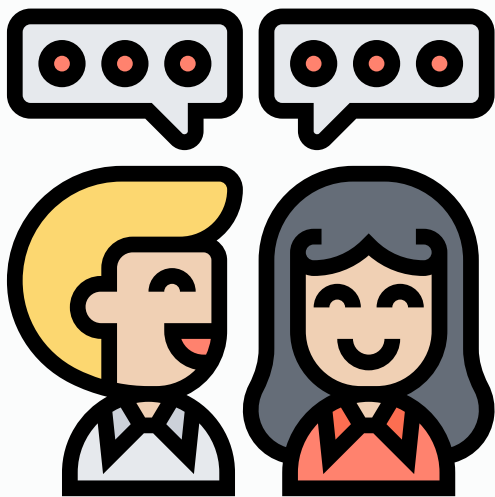
