Disregarded persons

• Student or student nurse

We will need a student exemption certificate. Please provide us with your original student certificate, which is available from your university or college registrar. This will be returned to you.

Apprentice

We require an <u>apprentice application form</u> completed by your employer, and one recent payslip.

• 18 and receives child benefit

We will need evidence child benefit is being paid such as DWP letter or bank statement.

Severely mentally impaired

We will need:

- o a completed severely mentally impaired application form
- o doctor's certificate
- o evidence of qualifying benefit. The General Medical Services Committee of the BMA has agreed medical certificates for this purpose should be issued free of charge to the applicant or his/her representative.

In detention

We will need a letter from the prison confirming the date of detention and expected release date.

• Resident in hospital

We will need a letter confirming the name and address of the hospital and that the stay is permanent (minimum of six months).

• Resident in nursing/care home

We will need a letter confirming the name and address of the care home and that the stay is permanent.

Care worker

We will need written confirmation the carer lives there, works at least 24 hours per week and earns no more than £44 per week.

Caring for someone with a disability

We will need:

- o a completed carer's application form and evidence of a qualifying benefit
- o the person being cared for must be over 18
- o you will not qualify for this discount if the person you care for is your spouse/partner or your own child under 18 years of age

Resident in a hostel

We will need a letter confirming residency in a hostel and the name and address of the hostel.

• Member of a religious community

We will need a letter confirming the person is dependent on the community for all their material needs.

• Under 20 and still at school or a recent school leaver

We will need written confirmation from the school.

• Non-British spouse or dependant of a student

We will need confirmation of the terms of their residency in the UK and that they cannot work or claim benefit.

• Member of an International HQ or defence organisation

We will need a letter from the applicable International HQ or defence organisation.

• Diplomatic immunity or privileges

We will need a letter from the relevant embassy.

• Member or dependant of a visiting force

We will need a letter from the visiting force headquarters.
