

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Tarsset with Greystead) Order 2023

Made on 28th June 2023

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

Northumberland County Council (“the Council”) in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 2nd November 2022. The review has been conducted in accordance with the terms of reference issued by the Council.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Tarsset with Greystead) Order 2023.
- (2) The Order shall come into force on the 1 April 2024
- (3) Article 4 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in year 2025
- (4) For the purposes of:-
 - (a) this article; and
 - (b) proceedings preliminary or relating to the election(s) of Parish Councillors for the parish of Tarsset with Greystead, to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2025,

this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Intepretation

2. In this Order -

“County” means the county of Northumberland

“Map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Northumberland County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Tarset with Greystead) Order 2023” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number

“Registration office” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983”

Effect of Order

- 3.** This order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order. Unless amended by this this order the governance arrangements of the parish concerned are unchanged
- 4.** Wards and number of parish councillors for the parish of Tarset with Greystead:
 - (1) The existing wards of the parish of Tarset with Greystead shall be abolished.
 - (2) The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Tarset with Greystead shall be eight (8)

Electoral register

- 5.** The registration officer for Northumberland shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order

Order date

- 6.** 1st April 2024 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

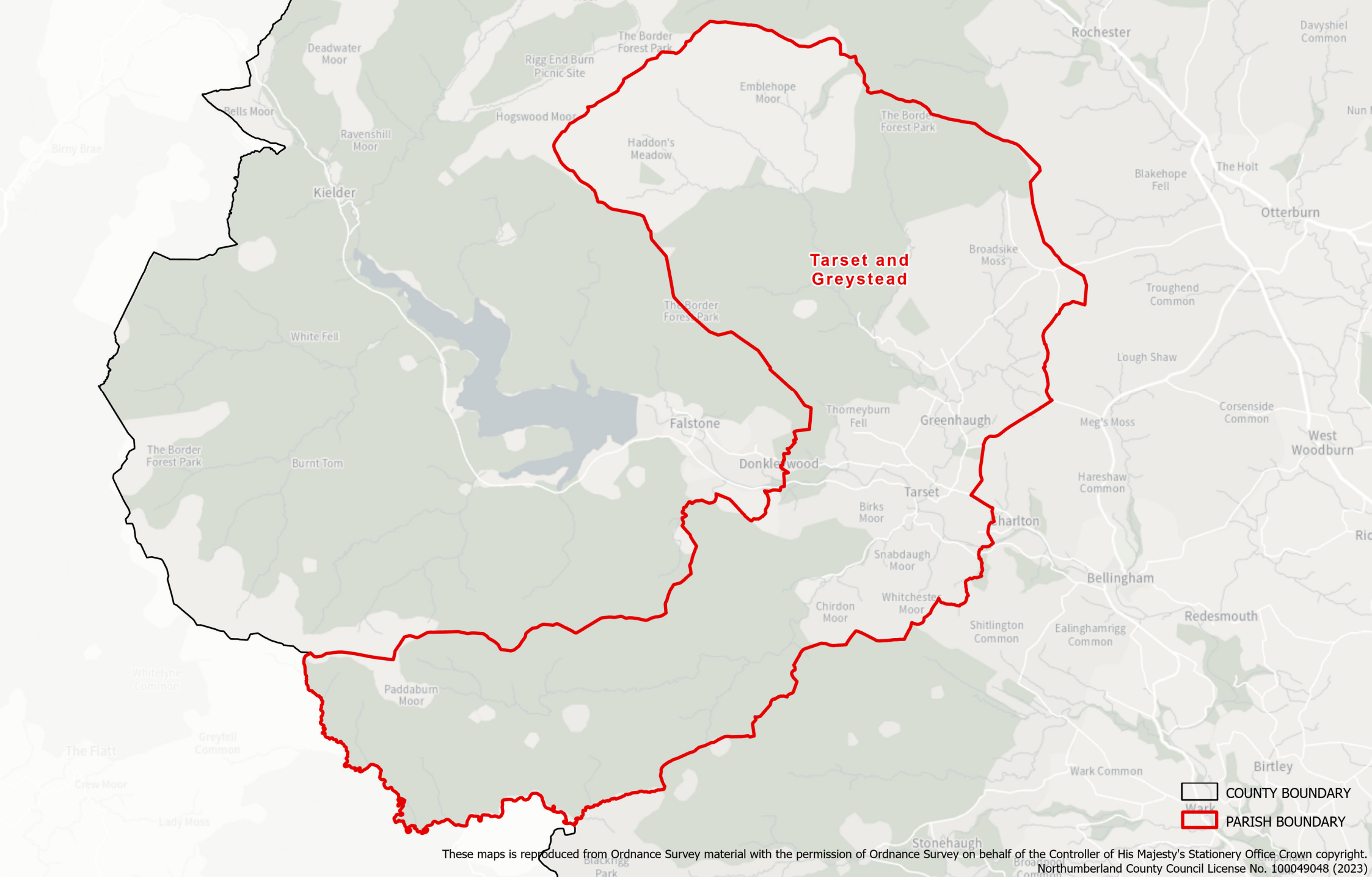
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for the Parish of Tarsset with Greystead within the County of Northumberland.

This Order abolishes the wards in the Parish and retains the number of parish councillors for Tarsset with Greystead as eight. The order comes into force on 1 April 2024.

The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2025.

The map defined in article 2 shows the parish of Tarsset with Greystead. It is available at all reasonable times, at the offices of Northumberland County Council.
