

# **LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007**

## **The Northumberland County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Corbridge) Order 2021**

*Made 05 March 2021*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

Northumberland County Council ("the Council"), in accordance with section 83(b) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2017.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

### **Citation and Commencement**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Northumberland County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Corbridge) Order 2021
- (2) This Order shall come into force on 1st April 2021.
- (3) For the purposes of:
  - (a) this article; and
  - (b) proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of Parish Councillors for the parish of Corbridge to be held on the ordinary day of election of Councillors in 2021.

this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

### **Interpretation**

2. In this Order-

"County" means the County of Northumberland

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the Northumberland County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Corbridge) Order 2021" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act and any

reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983

### **Effect of Order**

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreement about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

### **Wards and number of parish councillors for the parish of Corbridge:**

4. (1) The existing wards of the parish of Corbridge shall be abolished.  
(2) The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Corbridge shall be eleven (11).


### **Electoral Register**

5. The registration officer for the County shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of this Order.

### **Order Date**

6. 1st April 2021 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for the Parish of Corbridge within the County of Northumberland.

This order abolishes the wards in the parish and retains the number of parish councillors for Corbridge as eleven. The order comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2021.

The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of the election of councillors in 2021.

The map defined in article 2 shows the parish of Corbridge. It is available, at all reasonable times, at the offices of Northumberland County Council.

The map displays the Corbridge Civil Parish (CP) in Northumberland, outlined in black. The River Tyne flows through the center, with Corbridge town situated on its banks. To the north, the parish includes areas like Whitlington Fell and Pike Hill. To the west, it covers Sandhoe and Dilston. To the east, it includes Halton and Aydon.
