English and Maths (Free courses for adults*)

Functional Skills courses are based on real life situations/activities and can be adapted to suit your own needs. Here are some practical examples, which will vary from level to level. On a FS English course you may for example learn how to write or answer an email, how to prepare for and do a job interview, discuss the news or use a cash machine. On a FS Maths course you may learn how to calculate the amount of paint you need to apply for two coats on a living room wall and ceiling, or how to calculate percentages on a credit card repayment.

Functional Skills English and Maths are a mandatory component of Diplomas, Foundation Learning Programmes and apprenticeships. They can be studied as a stand-alone qualification or as a stepping stone to GCSE. Our courses range from Entry Level 1 to Level 2 (equivalent to a D at GCSE).

Who is this course for?	This course if for anyone aged 16 or over who needs an up to date Maths qualification or wants to top up their existing skills and qualifications.
What will I study? (Key modules or content)	NCFE Functional Skills qualifications are ideal qualification for learners wishing to develop practical, transferable skills in Mathematics in order to work confidently, effectively and independently in life.
	Functional Skills in Maths are a mandatory component of Diplomas, Foundation Learning Programmes and apprenticeships. They can be studied as a stand-alone qualification or as a stepping stone to GCSE.
	NCFE Functional Skills in Maths courses are based on real life situations/activities and can be adapted to suit your own needs.
	When you join a class we will assess your skills and you will be guided by expert tutors towards nationally recognised adult qualifications. Assessment for FS Maths is by a single examination at the end of the course.

What will I study? (Key modules or content)	ESOL support speakers of other languages based within the UK to develop their English language skills for work, further learning or everyday life. Use new vocabulary and simple grammar that will help you to ask and answer questions • Ask and give travel information • Make an appointment with the doctor and ask for medicines at the chemist • Ask for and give simple directions • Talk and write about your family, friends and yourself • Understand signs, symbols and instructions • Read and write some letters, notes, emails and simple forms.
